


Street Lighting Trouble Reporting (SLTR) Is there a street light out in your neighborhood?

To report a street light by phone

- Call DTE Energy at 800.477.4747 or contact your city or township offices.
- To report city of Detroit street light outages, call the city's Public Lighting Department at 313.267.7266.


Things to know

When reporting a street light problem, please provide as much information as possible (type of pole, exact location of pole, pole #). Remember to provide your contact information (in case we need more details, or to let you know the status of the repair). The normal repair time is 3-5 business days, with underground cable issues and pole replacements taking longer.

Street Lighting Trouble Reporting (SLTR)
