(Potential or Actual) Public Health | EMERGENCY

- Any event that has <u>potential</u> to escalate and threaten a community or public health;
- Any indicator of a <u>potential</u> chemical or radiological event, spill or release;
- Activation of a requests for specialized medical assets;
- Local hospitals or clinics appear to be rapidly approaching surge;
- Indications of a (actual or potential) food, water, or environmental contamination;
- Clusters of sick or dead animals in the absence of reasonable explanation;
- The release of any (CDC) Category A Agent;
- Any rapidly emerging event that has potential to adversely impact this community large-scale.
