Unfinished Business:

Memorial Park Comcast – Motion by Barnum, support by Kinyon to add additional channels to lineup. Motion carried.

Memorial Park Pavilions – Motion by Montalvo, support by Barnum to accept quote by S. P Gates Construction to reroof pavilions 3 – 5 at a cost of \$13,320. Motion carried.

Park Outdoor Grills – Motion by Montalvo, support by Barnum to accept the quote of Uline Products for the purchase of eight (8) outdoor grills at an approximate cost of \$3,008.58. Motion carried.

New Business:

Memorial Park Food Truck Permit – a vendor fee of \$25 and application are required for food trucks.

Hoover Park Grills – three (3) outdoor grills were approved (see above); a new sandbox will be constructed; the basketball poles will be painted and new swings installed. Water needs to be turned on.

Wm. P. Thompson Pond – Algae Treatment – motion by Kinyon, support by Montalvo to have the pond treated for algae at a cost of \$1,750 prior to the fishing clinic on June 10th. Motion carried.

Motion by Barnum, support by Montalvo to have the pond treated a second time, if necessary, at a cost of \$1,750. Motion carried.
