# A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A FINAL PROJECT PLAN FOR WATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS AND DESIGNATING AN AUTHORIZED PROJECT REPRESENTATIVE

**WHEREAS,** Port Huron Charter Township recognizes the need to make improvements to its existing water treatment and distribution system; and

**WHEREAS,** Port Huron Charter Township authorized DLZ-Michigan, Inc. to prepare a Project Plan, which recommends the replacement of approximately 15,000 lineal feet of undersized watermain, the installation of an electromagnetic flow meter at the Water Street Booster Station, and the replacement of 2,100 customer water meters; and

WHEREAS, said Project Plan was presented at a Public Hearing on June 20, 2022 and all public comments have been considered and addressed; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** that Port Huron Charter Township formally adopts said Project Plan and agrees to implement the selected alternative (Alternative 2).

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that the Township Supervisor, a position currently held by Robert Lewandowski, Jr., is designated as the authorized representative for all activities associated with the project referenced above, including the submittal of said Project Plan as the first step in applying to the State of Michigan for a Drinking Water State Revolving Fund Loan to assist in the implementation of the selected alterative.

# St. Clair County, Michigan

# Ordinance No. 250

An Ordinance to designate an enforcing agency to discharge the responsibilities of the Charter Township of Port Huron, located in St. Clair County, Michigan, and to designate regulated flood hazard areas under the provisions of the State Construction Code Act, Act 230 of Michigan Public Acts of 1972, as amended.

The Charter Township of Port Huron, St. Clair County, Michigan ordains:

**Section 1**. AGENCY DESIGNATED. Pursuant to the provisions of the State Construction Code, in accordance with Section 8b(6) of Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, the Port Huron Township Chief Building Official, as appointed by the Charter Township of Port Huron, Michigan is hereby designated as the enforcing agency (person) to discharge the responsibilities of the Charter Township of Port Huron, under Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, State of Michigan. The Charter Township of Port Huron assumes responsibility for the administration and enforcement of said Act throughout the corporate limits of the community adopting this ordinance

**Section 2**. CODE APPENDIX ENFORCED. Pursuant to the provisions of the State Construction Code, in accordance with Section 8b(6) of Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, Appendix G of the Michigan Building Code shall be enforced by the enforcing agency within the jurisdiction of the community adopting this ordinance.

Section 3. DESIGNATION OF REGULATED FLOOD PRONE HAZARD AREAS. The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Flood Insurance Study (FIS) Entitled "Flood Insurance Study for St. Clair, County, Michigan, (all jurisdictions)" and dated July 19, 2022, and the Flood Insurance Rate Map(s) (FIRMS) panel number(s) of 26147C0219D, 26147C0238D, 26147C0335D, 26147C0345D, 26147C0352D, 26147C0355D, 26147C0365D, effective, May 3, 2010, and 26147CIND0B, 26147C0239E, effective July 19, 2022, are adopted by reference for the purposes of administration of the Michigan Construction Code, and declared to be a part of Section 1612.3 of the Michigan Building Code, and to provide the content of the "Flood Hazards" section of Table R301.2(1) of the Michigan Residential Code.

**Section 4**. REPEALS. All ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

**Section 5**. PUBLICATION. This ordinance shall take immediate effect after legal publication and in accordance with the provisions of the Act governing same.
