Park Reports:

Lions Den #1:

The BBQ pipe needs to be taken out by the front of the building.
Cushion material for under playground equipment needed.
Poles on tire swing need to be painted. Don will contact Scout office for Eagle Scout project.
Scrubs need to be taken out around the "Lion", leaving the Blue Spruce tree.
Cement picnic tables and benches need to be power washed and painted, bench seat replaced.
A sign (rusted) on a tree needs to be removed.
Does the water faucet work out front?
Branches need to be picked up around pavilion and other areas in park.
Gravel in parking area up front is needed.

R.V. Park #2:

Gravel is ordered, waiting delivery. Pot holes need to be fixed also.
Shed is in disrepair. Estimates for a 24 X 24 shed will be needed.

Memorial Park #3:

Weeds in front of bench by the river need to be cleared. Piles of debris removed also.
Sign needs fixing.
Grass clippings need to be taken care of, including two piles of rubbish from trees needs to be burned.
Picnic tables look good.
Diamond #3 needs work - too wet now.
Fence around dumpster needs to be done.
Crack in cement where soccer dumpster is.
Railroad tie broken down along first base line.
Flowers needed.

Wm P. Thompson Pond #4:


Gravel in driveway. Grate under bridge needs cleaning.
