RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Pasquale R. Acciavatti Trust owns a parcel of property located in the Charter Township of Port Huron identified as parcel number 74-28-006-1017-002 which is approximately 38.4607 acres (the "Property"); and

WHEREAS, the Pasquale R. Acciavatti Trust wishes to donate the Property to the Charter Township of Port Huron; and

WHEREAS, the Pasquale R. Acciavatti Trust retained Midwest Appraisal by Louis C. Petho, III to determine the fair market value of the Property applying USPAP standards; and

WHEREAS, the appraiser determined the fair market value of the Property to be \$445,000.00 and the Charter Township of Port Huron has received a copy of the appraisal; and

WHEREAS, the Port Huron Township Board of Trustees has determined that acceptance of the proposed gift of the Property will serve a public purpose and that it is in the best interests of the Township and its Residents to acquire the Property.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, as follows, based on the recitals set forth above:

 The Charter Township of Port Huron accepts the donation of the Property which shall continuously be used for a public purpose as determined by the Township Board; and

RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE ST. CLAIR COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

WHEREAS, the Charter Township of Port Huron recognizes the threat that natural, social, and technological hazards pose to people and the community; and

WHEREAS, the mission of the Charter Township of Port Huron includes the charge to protect the health, safety, and the general welfare of the people of Port Huron Township; and

WHEREAS, undertaking hazard mitigation actions will reduce the potential harm to people and property from future hazard occurrences; and

WHEREAS, St. Clair County, with the assistance of a Hazard Mitigation Plan Steering Committee, comprised of representatives from the County, municipalities, and stakeholder organizations, has prepared a recommended Hazard Mitigation Plan that reviews the options to protect people and reduce damage from these hazards; and

WHEREAS, Port Huron Township has participated in the planning process for development of this Plan, providing information specific to local hazard priorities and encouraging public participation; and

WHEREAS, on August 18, 2022, the St. Clair County Board of Commissioners adopted the St. Clair County Hazard Mitigation Plan as a Committee of the Whole, as an official document of the County, pursuant to the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (PL-106-390) and associated regulations (42 CFR 210.6); and

WHEREAS, on July 15, 2015, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) officially approved the St. Clair County Hazard Mitigation Plan, making the County and its participating communities eligible for disaster mitigation funding; and

WHEREAS, an adopted hazard mitigation plan is required as a condition of future funding for multiple FEMA pre and post disaster mitigation grant programs; and

WHEREAS, the Plan has been widely circulated for review by the County's residents, municipal officials, and state, federal, and local review agencies and has been revised to reflect their concerns:
